FROM GIRL TO GIRL, the film of the creative team of the online series Girl Seeks Girl could be made a reality with the help of its fans.

- *After the success achieved six years ago with the online series Girl Seeks Girl, the team reconvenes to launch its new project: the film From Girl to Girl.*
- *The online series, a pioneer of content aimed at the LGTB audience, won many festival prizes and achieved success in more than fifteen countries.*
- *The project is a response to the clamour of more than twenty thousand fans who over six years have enjoyed with it.*

The creative team of the Girl Seeks Girl series now seeks to make the leap to the big screen with a must-see film which chimes with the times in which we live: featuring new content and also new ways of producing cinema.

The film, entitled *From Girl to Girl*, seeks the support of its audience in developing the project through the crowdfunding system, calling for all the fans that the series has generated and continues to generate, whether in Spain, Latin America, the United States or the other countries in which the series was a success, to become co-producers.

Featuring a top quality cast, *From Girl to Girl* is a comedy which stars Celia Freijeiro, Sandra Collantes, Cristina Pons, María Ballesteros, María Botto, Alexandra Jimenez, Diego Martín, Miguel Angel Muñoz, Gorka Otxoa, Eulalia Ramón, Estefanía de los Santos, Adriana Torrebejano. It is directed by Sonia Sebastián.

The series Girl Seeks Girl, the source for the project which was broadcast on the internet more than six years ago, was a pioneer in Spain, as it became a success through offering content aimed at the LGTB audience. At present videos of the series are still accumulating thousands of views throughout the world, some of its episodes managing to exceed 5 million on YouTube. The DVD is also still in distribution both in Spain and in the United States. But the run of the series did not finish online and it was screened at numerous festivals: in 2008 at the Canary Islands Festival del Sol and the Cordoba Ítem and in 2009 at Festivals in Rochester, Philadelphia, Miami, New York, Carolina, San Francisco, Albuquerque New Mexico, Washington, Seattle, Boston Festival, Melbourne and City of Santa Cruz, as well as at Film Fresh.
